10.00 | Young Horses

The first session of the day will explore the breeding and selection process and the early management of young horses.

10.45 | Inexperienced Horses – Training and Competition

Session two will focus on comparing the development of young or inexperienced horses, examining early training techniques, and exploring how to introduce new environments. Two demo riders will feature: one working on introducing new movements, and another showcasing a more established combination.

11.45 | Developing Lateral Work

This session will compare approaches to introducing lateral work and developing way of going at Elementary and Medium levels. With two combinations, one new to Elementary/Medium, and another already established at Medium.

12.30 | Lunch break

13.30 | Progressive Performance

To start the afternoon, session four will focus on developing the competition horse — introducing new movements and advancing the way of going through the levels. Two demo riders at Advanced Medium will take to the arena: one new to the level, and one established or progressing toward Advanced.

14.30 | Sustainable Progress

This session will look at the development through to FEI levels, covering sustainable training methods and effective horse management both in and out of the arena, featuring demo riders at Small Tour.

15.00 | Maintaining Big Tour

The day's final session will focus on maintaining performance levels and planning for a horse's post-competition career, including managing horses new to Grand Prix versus those already established, while ensuring ongoing wellbeing.
