Riders in B, B+ or A squad riding young horses Aged 5 or 6 (to the end of the calendar year) will compete in their Squad Level but may choose to ride the relevant young horse test. One set of rosettes and prizes will be given at each Squad Level and riders placed in line with the marks awarded. There will be no separate Young Horse Classes or prizes.

D & C Squad Riders may have whips and commanders

Prizes: Rosettes, prizes, and sashes will be awarded to the winning teams and individuals over the two days on Sunday at the prize giving.

Team Championship

- Teams will be selected in accordance with the Regional Team Selection Policy 2026.
- All scoring for team and individual competitions will be based on combined scores (Marks)
- Each team of 4 will have a drop score on each day. The rider with the lowest score will not count towards the team average.
- Each team to comprise of four riders from the region who have been assessed as current members of one of the following squads: D, C, C+, B, B+, A
- Teams must include riders from at least three different squads.
- Teams of 3 riders are permitted but must consist of 3 riders from different levels. All 3 scores will count. If a team drops to two members, they may still ride in the competition for individual placings. However, the competition is a team competition and therefore will not start with any individual riders.
- Riders in D and C Squad may carry a whip and have a caller in the team competition.
- Team and individual results will be determined when each combination at each level has completed their test and the scores have been calculated. The results will be notified to the regional representatives, and the test sheets will then be released, and each rider will be given the opportunity to check their sheets. A period of 30 minutes after the test sheets have been released will be allowed for the riders to notify their regional representative of any issue or error and for the regional representative to report this to the scorers. If no issue has been raised within the given period, then the published results will stand and cannot thereafter be challenged.
- Individual Champions will also be awarded at each level:
- The individual championships will be determined from the individual results in the team classes - Rosettes and Prizes to 10th at the prize giving.

No additional teams will be permitted if regions do not send a full contingent.

Conditions of Entry and Qualification

As per Rules **189 & 192** of the British Dressage Members Handbook 2026. D Squad Riders and Horses/Ponies may compete with Club Membership. All other riders must be full BD members with fully registered horses and must adhere to the British Dressage code of conduct for Horse Welfare and members.

Riders must adhere to British Dressage 2026 Regional Selection Policy guidelines set down for team selection.

Horses/Ponies must be vaccinated as per **rule 10** of the British Dressage Members Handbook

Any riders found in breach of the selection policy may be eliminated.

General Exercise and Arena Walks

General Exercise in the warmup arenas available from 15:00 on Friday until dusk.

Arena walks will be split across the regions and notified before the event. You must walk in your allocated time. This is in walk, mounted (by the competitor), with competition number worn as directed by the steward.

Exercise of Horses

The warmup arenas will be stewarded when in use. Riders competing will have priority, riders exercising and competing later will be allowed if space allows and permitted by the steward. Bridle numbers must be always worn when horses are out of their stables.

Entertainment

Introduction & Briefing Friday night in the Primrose Suit, followed at 19:00 by complimentary soft drinks. Regions will host their own meetings **after this**. There will be entertainment on Saturday night.

Chef d'equipe

There will be a Chef d'equipe's meeting on Friday at 18:00 in the DO meeting room.

Contact details of all Chef d'equipe's should be sent by email, prior to arrival.

Entry Information

Entries will be made via Equipe. A link will be provided on email to selected riders.

An indication of how many teams and individuals being sent from each region must be sent to DO Nikki Birt, NW DO at nikki.birt@britishdressage.co.uk by the closing date.

Closing date: 12 June 2026

(Please note that after close of entries **no refunds** will be given)

Entry Fees: £65 per rider (riders must enter inter-regional classes Sat & Sun)
£25 entry for Classes 1 – 7 (warm up classes)

Substitutions will be accepted after the close of entries until the 26 June.
However, **no refunds** will be given.

Stabling

On-site stabling. Stables will be empty of bedding. Bales can be purchased for £12 a bale from the site managers office.

Duration of Show (Friday to Sun) £140 (Additional nights Thursday or Sunday can be booked with entries at £50.00) A cash deposit per region will be taken arrival and returned on inspection prior to leaving. All stables will have 2 bales of shavings provided.

Shavings only. Shavings can be purchased on arrival from the stable manager and will be delivered to the stables area.

All arrivals are requested to be on site by Friday 22:00.

Please state on entries if you are bringing a stallion.

Stables are allocated in regions where possible (except for stallions) and stable plans will be clearly visible on arrival. Stabling will be open from Friday 12pm stables need to be vacated and cleared within 1 hour after prize giving has concluded.

Hook Up

Hook up is available at a fee of £70.00 for the duration of the competition (12pm Friday- end of competition Sunday). This is payable with entries.

First Aid

There are on site first aiders, please ask the steward or secretary in the office should you require help as they will prioritise the arenas.

Security

In the interest of onsite security and health and safety - parents, partners and guests will be issued with a security wristband which must be worn for the duration of the competition.

Please ensure that valuables are always secure and that your vehicles always remain locked. All property remains the responsibility of the individual and Kelsall Hill will not take responsibility for personal items.

Lorry Park

There is ample parking for lorries and ample hook ups.

Parking area for each region will be published with times. Cars will be provided allocated parking spaces which will not be in the same area as lorries.

Toilets and Shower Facilities

The Toilets & Showers are always open.

Catering

The café (daytime) and bar (evening) will be open throughout the weekend, providing food until end of day.

Dogs

Dogs are NOT allowed in stables, competition arenas or warm up arenas. Dogs must be always kept on leads and owners must clear up after them.

Prize Giving.

Prize giving and the closing ceremony will take place approximately 45 minutes after the last test on Sunday. This will be unmounted in the Indoor Arena. All riders must be present in full riding attire.

General Rules and Conduct

Only riders entered into a class at a competition may ride their horse for the duration of the show, including those running over multiple days. Another rider may exercise the horse on a long rein at walk under supervision of the steward or marshal (who is to be notified)

In the interests of health and safety, the directions of the stewards and organisers must be always followed. Competitors and supporters are expected to conduct themselves in a manner befitting the nature of the sport and the spirit of friendly competition in line with the 2026 British Dressage Members code of conduct. All competitors will be bound by the BD code of conduct and social media policy and Social Media policy.

Rude and abusive behaviour towards people and / or animals will not be tolerated and those in contravention of this will be asked to leave.

Emergency telephone numbers and contact numbers will be posted at the Secretary's Office

Please note that some areas are designated judges/officials only and riders are requested to respect these areas.

Vet / Farrier

Vet contact details will be posted at the reception.

A list of local farriers can be supplied in the event of emergency – info at reception. There is however no guarantee that a farrier will be able to attend the centre during the weekend. Please therefore ensure that your horse / pony is well shod.

Photographer
